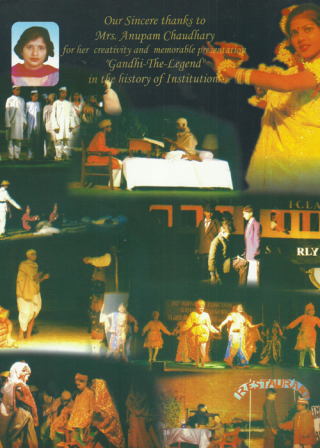

WHAT MAKES US FEEL COLD

If the chill is getting to you, don't blame the weather-blame bio chemistry.

"JOURNAL OF NEUROSCIENCE" explains how cold fibres that connect neurons near the spinal cord to nerve endings in the skin help us sense the cold.

What makes us feel cold is, of course, the absence of energy, or heat which is essentially the vibration of molecules. As molecules lose energy, they vibrate less- and their temperature drops.

When the cold air drains heat from our skin molecules, we go "bare". The faster energy is drained away, the colder it gets. This is called the wind chill factor. Wind increases heat loss making it seem colder than what the thermometer shows.

Low temperatures impair body functions as nerve cells and finger muscles work slowly. 12°C is critical for manual dexterity and 8°C for touch sensitivity. Low temperatures also weaken pain receptors, allowing ice packs to reduce the swelling and pain. When the skin temperature falls below 10°C, blood vessels dilate and constrict alternately as the body tries not to lose heat from the extremities, while keeping the blood supply to the skin going. So our cheeks and noses turn red in frosty weather.

समस्त उपलब्धियों का मूल है

‘मन’

अतः सफलता के लिये मन, बुद्धि और शरीर तीनों का समन्वय होना और समुत्पन्न रूप से कार्य करना आवश्यक है, जिनमें से मन के बारे में हमें यह जानना है कि वह बहुत बंधित होता है। मन की बंधितता के कारण हम अपना कार्य पूरी सतता के साथ नहीं कर पाते हैं। हम अक्सर यह अनुभव करते हैं कि जहाँ हम होते हैं वहाँ हमारा मन नहीं होता है, कहीं और खोया रहता है। कभी चरित्र की कल्पनाओं में उड़ाने पर रस होता है तो कभी अतीत की घटनाओं को सोचता रहता है और इस प्रकार हम कार्यभार को छोड़ देते हैं और हमारा व्यक्तिगत विचारने लगता है। परिणाम स्वल्प एकाग्रता भंग होने लगती है, और हमारे मन में शक्ति नहीं रहती। अतः सर्वप्रथम हमें मन में शक्ति लाने वाले गुणों को अपनाया चाहिए क्योंकि मन में शक्ति लाने वाले गुण व्यक्तिगत भेद के कारण अलग-2 हो सकते हैं, लेकिन कुछ विचार ऐसे होते हैं जो प्रायः सभी के मन को शान्त करके आत्मोन्मत्ति में सहायक होते हैं, जैसे-

अपनी पसंदी मान लेना अर्म की बात नहीं होती है।

कमा कर देना कषाया की बात नहीं होती है।

सहजगील होने का मतलब मजबूर होना नहीं है।

दैन्य धारण करना असहजता की बात नहीं होती अदि।

इस प्रकार हमें सर्वप्रथम मन की शक्ति के उपाय एवं मन की बंधितता को टोकने के लिये उद्देश्यपूर्ण जीवन-शैली अपनानी चाहिए। साथ ही साथ शरीर के स्वास्थ्य पर भी ध्यान देना उचित आवश्यक है क्योंकि स्वस्थ शरीर
